This is a very strange time for us, like never before. I am at home for over two months now. All the scheduled events are postponed. So, I am home with my wife our daughter, her husband and the grandchildren. It is incredible!!! Just talking to Aurora, the other day that beside the great vacation we had last year in the US (visiting you) we have now the best time of our lives. Together, at home having time for whatever we want. Of course, I do some teaching and preaching online as the ministry goes on, but finally we have the time we always wanted with each other.



We had two terrifying weeks though as Aurora was infected and was very sick. In Romania, Arad is the third most infected city in Romania after Suceava (where I was to go at the end of this month to teach) and Bucharest.
