I just want to praise the Lord during this crazy time. Even though there are so many difficult things I keep thinking of how He is sustaining and looking after His ministry.

This year at National was a record year in bookings. These bookings help fund the internship program and our expansion fund. Although they have taken a big hit this last month it is nothing compared to what it would have been a couple years ago. He prepared us to sustain this. I just keep thinking about how we can't be tied to our system or formula for doing ministry but instead be willing to adapt and adjust in order to meet needs. CBM has a history of doing this in the past.
