Trivandrum, India (F.B.M.I.)



Here in India some states in the north are still in lockdown. We are gradually coming back to a strange new normal in our southern state. They will allow public transportation but busses that once carried 75 now will only have 25-30. We now need permission papers to pass from one state to another. We are required to wear masks and keep 2 meters "social distance." A friend recently told me that people now see others as potential "carriers of death." Here are some excerpts from emails I received:

- **Pastor Sisudas Jena** "...At the same time meeting our daily needs, paying house rent is a challenge these days. House owner keeps calling for rent. We are going through the pressing need of meeting our daily needs. Kindly pray for us, the ministry and the pressing need..."
- **Pastor Laxman Singh Rawat (he and wife care for the Abused Girl's Home)** "Please pray for our believer who is a daily wage worker. They don't have food. Please pray for them. If you can help us, we can help them and please pray for all girls in Dehradun. Please pray for girl's notebook and books and food and other supplies for girls all needs. Please sir, continue to pray for us..."
- **Pastor P M Nayak** "Respected President sir, Thank you so much for your prayers for us always. Today 2 people found coronavirus positive in my district for first time in the district. 900 plus in entire Odisha."
- **Pastor Pabitra Mohan Nayak** "Respected sir, I greet you in the sweetest name of our Lord Jesus Christ. Thank you so much for the support in April. Due to lockdown we had no gathering meeting for support..."
- **Pastor Joy Kumar West Bengal** "The situation is very, very bad now. We are already in red zone and beside Corona in our state heavy cyclone is going on which is called cyclone Amphan. The storm is 150 km per hour. In these two ways we are in miserable condition. Please pray for us. Too much devastation has already taken place."

Our Summer Evangelistic Teams did as much as possible; including tract distribution and feeding the hungry with food kits of rice, Dal (chickpeas), ground wheat and potatoes. There is an awareness of fear and death in the hearts of the people around us. We are using this as an avenue to share the Life-giving gospel that brings forgiveness of sin, eternal life and hope in this time of insecurity. Please pray.

We are his ambassadors and must continue to communicate the gospel to the lost and dying around us because our precious Savior has warned us that we must work "while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work." I don't know when the night will come but we will continue to proclaim the gospel and do the works the Lord has entrusted to us right up until we breathe our last.

Current needs...

1. Food for Children's home for two months, school books and necessary things for education. And at least two computers cost \$3,500 average for each home. We have 18 homes but the need for 6 has already been met.
2. College electric bills are piled up; a few buildings need repair (plumbing and roof) and other necessary things. The need is \$9,000.
3. Food and essential things for helping widows, old folks' home and some rural area believers who are daily laborers that are out of work for the last few months. The need is \$7,500.
