What **TO BRING**

- ❑ Bedding & Pillow – Sleeping Bag or Twin Sheets & Blanket
- ❑ Personal Items – Toothbrush & paste / Soap / Shampoo / Towel
- ❑ Clothing – Modest Shorts & Shirts / PJ's
No short shorts, bare midribs or spaghetti straps please
- ❑ Tennis shoes are highly recommended rather than flip-flops!
- ❑ Swim Suit with athletic shorts & T-shirt to cover / Sunscreen / Towel
2 towels are recommended – one for swimming & one for shower
- ❑ Notebook / Pen / Bible with paper pages (not a phone or tablet)
- ❑ Flashlights are helpful

What **NOT TO BRING**

- No spending money is needed! Don't send snacks unless your child has a special diet. Let us know if your child has restrictions.

- Knives/weapons, matches/lighters, and fireworks are prohibited.
