

# 2019 Junior Camp Memory Verses

This year we will study the life of

## DAVID

from **1 Samuel** chapters **16-17** and  
**Psalms 51**

**READ** and **STUDY** these chapters from the Bible.  
**PRAY** and ask the Lord to help you remember His  
Word and understand His plan for your life as you  
**THINK** about these passages.

### Verses

There are 10 verses to memorize.

Say them to your leader during any  
free time at camp – one at a time,  
in any order is fine.

Earn points when you say each  
verse -- plus double points for  
quoting all 10 of them!

- Learn verses for Bible Quiz
- Learn references for Bible Drill

### Bible Drill

You will be challenged to find the 10 memory  
verses in the Bible during a Bible Drill.

Be sure to learn the **REFERENCES** and  
**PRACTICE** looking them up in your Bible!

**Spending a little time every day working on  
the verses is better than spending a lot of time  
right before we leave for camp – so get busy!**

### Bible Quizzing

Each camper will be assigned  
to a quiz team and will compete  
against other teams each day.

Be the first to hit your buzzer  
and answer the question  
to earn points for your team!

Questions will be taken from  
the assigned chapters from  
Genesis and the 10 memory verses.

As you study, challenge yourself  
to think of questions that might  
be asked during quizzing.

### Theme Verses and Songs

We will learn some of the verses as scripture  
songs which can help you learn the words.  
**Our theme verses will be Colossians 3:23-24.**

### Extra Challenge

There are more verses you can learn if you  
want an extra challenge and extra points.

The verses from these passages must be  
quoted all together in one sitting.

There will be **NO QUIZ QUESTIONS** asked  
from these extra challenge verses.

### Bible Versions

Verses are printed in four different  
versions. Choose to memorize and  
study from the one that is best for  
you.

## NEW INTERNATIONAL VERSION

- Joshua 1:9** Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.

**Joshua 1:9 (KJV) will be the theme verse we will quote together before each meal.**

- 1 Samuel 16:7b** The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart.
- 1 Samuel 18:14** In everything he did he had great success, because the LORD was with him.
- Psalms 51:10** Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
- Proverbs 28:13** Whoever conceals their sins does not prosper, but the one who confesses and renounces them finds mercy.
- Luke 16:10** Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much.
- Romans 13:14** Rather, clothe yourselves with the Lord Jesus Christ, and do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh
- Colossians 3:23** **Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters,**
- Colossians 3:24** **Since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.**
- 2 Timothy 1:7** For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

These passages are not required – just for extra credit. You can choose to say just one or all four – each section must be said in one sitting. No quiz questions will be asked from these extra verses. The highlighted verses are ones you are already learning!

### Joshua 1 : 7 - 9

<sup>7</sup> Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go.

<sup>8</sup> Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.

<sup>9</sup> **Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go.**

### Psalm 51 : 1 – 4 and 10

<sup>1</sup> Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions.

<sup>2</sup> Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin.

<sup>3</sup> For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.

<sup>4</sup> Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight; so you are right in your verdict and justified when you judge.

<sup>10</sup> **Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.**

### Luke 16 : 10 - 13

<sup>10</sup> **Whoever can be trusted with very little can also be trusted with much, and whoever is dishonest with very little will also be dishonest with much.**

<sup>11</sup> So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches?

<sup>12</sup> And if you have not been trustworthy with someone else's property, who will give you property of your own?

<sup>13</sup> No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.
